International Symposium on 3D Analysis of Human Movement
in Uruguay, Latin America, December 2024

At the Symposium: the oral presentations schedule is tight therefore, we kindly ask you to stick to the scheduled time. Presentation authors should reach the conference room well before the beginning of their session. A windows PC will be available for uploading your presentation in ppt or pdf from a pendrive. The time assigned to oral presentation is 12 minutes, with room for a short question and answer. Chairmen of the sessions will check the time and emit a first signal at 10 minutes and ask to close after 12 minutes.

Poster presentations are either assigned to Poster Session A or Session B. An A1 size (59 x 84 cm) poster template is available at www.3dahm2024.com. Please make sure your poster is hung at least one hour before the Poster Session (either A or B) starts because juries will act before general public is admitted.

The general program is available at www.3dahm2024.com where the detailed program will also be available. Please check your session date & time. Full paper preparation: authors who have been selected to prepare the complete paper and have agreed it to be send to IEEE Xplore, please follow the steps specified at the IEEE Xplore platform. Please note that acceptance of the oral communication does not mean acceptance of the paper. Paper will be reviewed and checked for plagiarism & self-plagiarism before acceptance. You will be asked to sign a Copyright transfer to IEEE, and add the following copyright notice at the bottom of the first page of your source document:
